


InSpire Canada Math Contest - Student Handbook

This handbook guides individual students through registration, payment, redeeming reward, practice with a sample test, joining the official contest, test-day rules, and how to view results, rankings, and certificates.

Referrals

1) Create Your Account

1) Use a refer link or go to https://math-contest.org to register.




- 2) Use student's real name and a personal email you can access.
- 3) After registering, you can update your password and profile in User Account \rightarrow Settings.



2) Pay for Annual Access




• Pay from your dashboard after login.





Individual plan: \$18 CAD per year. Payment unlocks access to official contests throughout the year and view results/certificates on the site.



3) \$5 Reward — How You Earn It and Redeem It

How you earn \$5:

• If you registered using someone's referral link and completed one individual paid, you receive \$5 CAD.

Important rules:

• Access gained only through a Group purchase does NOT qualify for the referral reward; an individual payment is required.



Redeem:

• Open the Referral page (after login) to see your balance.




Refer a friend and you both will earn \$5

- Both you and your friend earn \$5 CAD once they register and pay for their first contest using your referral code.
- To redeem your earnings, simply provide your E-Transfer information below.



• In Canada: enter your Interac e-Transfer information on the Referral page to redeem.




- Outside Canada: email support@math-contest.org to arrange payout.
- Typical processing time: 2–3 business days after request.




4) Try the Sample Test

- Before your first contest, practice with the Sample Test to learn the interface.
- Log in → click Contests → choose Sample Test



• Select your grade and **Start Contest**.





5) Join the Official Contest

Schedule & duration:

- Contests are typically held mid-month on Wednesday and Thursday.
- Your school/center chooses the exact time. Each contest lasts 45 minutes.

Upcoming Mathematics Contests

Students can start the contest on either contest day, within their school's Contest Time Window (7:30 AM – 10:30 PM local time). Once begun, the student has 45 consecutive minutes to complete the test.

Time Window: 7:30 AM – 10:30 PM (local time). Two-day window per round; start anytime within the window.

Date	Grades
15th(Wed) & 16h(Thu) October, 2025	Grades 1–6
12th(Wed) & 13th(Thu) November, 2025	Grades 1–6
14th(Wed) & 15th(Thu) January, 2026	Grades 1–6
11th(Wed) & 12th(Thu) February, 2026	Grades 1–6
8th(Wed) & 9th(Thu) April, 2026	Grades 1–6
6th(Wed) & 7th(Thu) May, 2026	Grades 1–6

Before the start:

- Log in 5–10 minutes early, open the contest page, and select the correct grade.
- Have pencils/eraser and scrap paper ready.

During the contest:

- The page shows a countdown timer and may use video proctoring.
- Do NOT leave or refresh the page; leaving can clear answers and reduce remaining time.
- Questions are single-choice (one correct answer).


Submitting:

• Click Submit when finished. If time runs out, your work is auto-submitted.



After the contest:

• Do not share or discuss exam questions online on Wednesday or Thursday (live contest days). Violations can lead to disqualification.



6) Test-Day Integrity Checklist

- Stable internet and a quiet room.
- Camera on.
- No extra apps, tabs, phones, or calculators unless allowed.
- Stay on the contest page until you submit.

7) Results, Rankings, and Certificates

Release timeline:

• Results usually appear within 2 days after your contest, and no later than 1 week.

Where to view:


- Log in and open the Results page to see your score and ranking.
- You can filter rankings by grade.





Answer breakdown:

• Go to **Enrolled Contests** → choose your contest session to review your responses and missed items (**Enrolled Contests** is not available during the contest days).



Certificates:

• Two types are available: Participation and Ranking. Download them from the Certificates area.

8) Temporary Lock on Score Look-ups

• To protect exam integrity, from 2 days before a contest until results are released, score look-ups and history pages may be temporarily disabled.



9) Improve Your Profile Data

- Rankings use your Country / Province / City. Make sure they are accurate and spelled in full in User Account → Settings.
- Keep your email current so you can receive notifications and password resets.

10) Submit Your Own Problems (with Rewards)

- We encourage students to submit original, well-written problems.
- Send your problem to support@math-contest.org with: statement, options/answer, full solution, and attribution (your name/school/grade).
- If your problem is adopted, you may receive a reward and be featured on our site or social media.
